



What is Habitat Camp?

Habitat Camp is a summer day camp for High School Students ages 16 years +. Students will learn about basic construction skills such as carpentry, laying sod, planting trees, insulation and painting.

When is it?

Habitat Camp is a 4 day (Tuesday-Friday) program. The first session is July 7-10th. Additional sessions will be created based on need. Camp hours are from 7:30am - 2:30pm

How much is it?

A minimum donation of \$300 is required of all participants. Once the full amount is recieved your spot will be confirmed for the day. The donation covers the cost of tools, supplies, a Habitat t-shirt, lunches, snacks, water, Gatorade, supervision and training. The fee may be paid by check or by raising at least \$300 by doing a Build-a-thon.

What is a Build-a-thon?

A Build-a-thon is a Habitat Fundraiser. All participants must create a fundraising page at www.firstgiving.com/habitatbroward to register for camp. Students looking to fundraise, simply have to email their page to family and friends to get sponsors. This is a great way to get your friends and family involved too!

How do I sign up?

Go to www.firstgiving.com/habitatbroward and click on the Get Started button. Then select Habitat Camp and get started creating your page. Even if you plan to write a check, all Habitat Camp participants must register on the website.



What do I get if I raise more than \$300?

Students who raise/donate \$400 will receive a Habitat water bottle and golden hammer pin. Students who raise/donate \$500 will also receive a Habitat tote bag and framed certificate. Students who raise/donate \$1,000 or more will also receive a plaque.
